## History Carved in Stone (25 min)

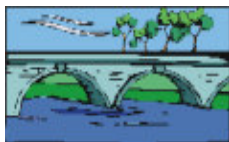
Learn about early Saskatoon residents by visiting their graves in the Nutana Cemetery.
